

What's new in the CogSci world?

Brain learns to see familiar faces in different retinal locations!

A study conducted by researchers at Dartmouth College aimed to study the spatial heterogeneity in the identification of personally familiar faces. In a series of two experiments, participants were shown morphed images of people of varying familiarity to them in different spatial locations of their peripheral visual field and asked to judge their identity. Collective results revealed that the participants consistently recognised the individual who was more familiar to them in different locations. Constant personal interaction with these individuals can result in learning which may alter the representation of these faces in the face-processing areas resulting in the retinotopic biases based on personal familiarity.
